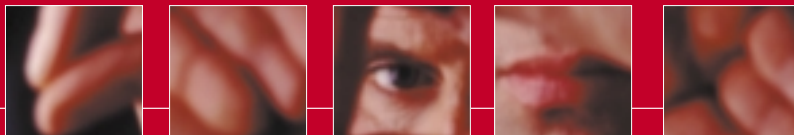
DEVELOPMENT

*Changing to meet your expectations*

The ESCRS is a vibrant society which is constantly evolving to meet the changing needs of its members. Strategies for the development of the organisation are monitored and reviewed, and feedback from members and delegates is encouraged. The ESCRS has appointed a lobbyist in Brussels to monitor EU developments relating to ophthalmology and to advise the ESCRS on how best to manage and participate in these developments. The ESCRS will engage with the EU on behalf of its members and do its best to influence EU policy in the best interests of ophthalmology. 'EU Mail' is a quarterly newsletter for ESCRS members which aims to track the impact of the European Union on ophthalmic practice and to offer commentary on the latest news from the European Commission, Parliament, Council of Ministers and Court of Justice. The ESCRS also supports several research projects, including the European Cataract Outcomes Study Group and an international multicentre endophthalmitis study.
